From the early 1990s, Annabelle concentrated on making sculptural art pieces about the human form and its coverings, looking at the function and cultural meaning of attire with reference to ideas about gender, the body and sexuality.

In more recent years Collett also investigated notions of camouflage, disguise, pattern and the affect of disruptions to pattern.

She is also known for a series of works with recycled and found plastics that focused on repurposing waste and challenged the widespread adoption of single-use plastics.
